



Fiber Fusion Northwest Fiber Arts Show

Entry Information & Rules 2024



All entries must be entered in online registration. Payment may be made online or by mail.

- ❖ Entries **MUST** contain 50% (or more) natural fibers. This includes wool, alpaca, cashmere, angora, linen, cotton, bamboo, hemp, tencel, etc.
- ❖ Enter your item(s) under the appropriate Fiber Arts Category
- ❖ Entries **MUST** remain on display: Saturday 10 am until Sunday 5 pm
- ❖ Entry pickup by Owner or designated person: Sunday 5-6 pm (see Entry Mail-In Options for shipping)

Remember!

Every entry MUST have attached 3" x 5" card with the following (No card - no entry!):

- No personal ID or price tags (*judging is anonymous*)
- Fiber content
- Statement of intended use
- **Note:** Spinners - include the proposed use for the yarn (i.e. socks, a shawl, etc)
- Preparation & techniques used in entry's creation
- Original or commercial design (if applicable)
- Fiber sample, yarn sample, or other component to demonstrate content
- How long you have been working on this skill (Ex: beginner, intermediate, advanced and/or # of years, etc)
- Anything else you would like the judge to know about your item

Registration

- ❖ All entries must be completed after our last event (June 2023).
- ❖ Go to <https://www.fiberfusion.net/fiber-arts-show-2024.html> for Online Registration, Class/Lot, etc.

You must PRE-REGISTER online!

- Payment can be handled separately.
- Mail-in payment deadline is 2 weeks earlier than online registration to allow for postal delays.

Payment

There are two payment options:

- ❖ 1: Online Payment Option: You can pay online as you complete your registration
 - Registration and payment are due no later than May, 29 2024.
 - ❖ 2: Mail-in Payment Option: **Register online**, then:
 - Print out the mail-in form. Form is available on the payment page after online registration.
 - Mail with payment to Fiber Fusion % NSAA, P.O. Box 1131, Stanwood, WA 98292.
- Mail-in payment must be postmarked no later than May 17, 2024 and received by May 29. Mail-in payment deadline is 2 weeks earlier than online to allow for postal delays.

Submitting your Fiber Art

There are 3 ways you may submit your Fiber Art entries to us **once you have PRE-REGISTERED online.**

1. MAIL-IN - Fiber Arts Entry

- Entries may be mailed to:

 - Entries must be postmarked no later than May 17, 2024 and received by May 29, 2024.
- Mail-in entries **MUST BE** accompanied by a pre-paid, pre-addressed, return label from the US Postal Service, and will be returned in the same box sent or in whatever container you provide.
- We will be unable to return ribbons and entries until shipping arrangements have been made.

2. SHOW ON-SITE CHECK-IN: Drop off your entries at the show site

- Friday from 2:00-7:00 pm
- **By arrangement only:** Saturday morning from 8:00-8:30 am.

3. REMOTE DROP OFF – You may hand deliver your items to a member of Team Fiber Fusion.

- Entries must be at the drop-off site no later than Wednesday, May 29 th, 2024
