Fleece Class Rules

- Pygora fleeces classes are determined by the fineness of the fiber, regardless of the age of the goat. The judge is allowed to move the fleece to the appropriate class if it has been entered into the incorrect class
- Fiber length will vary by fleece type. Appropriate fiber lengths are as follows:
 1. Type “A”: 6+ inches
 2. Type “B”: 3 – 6 inches
 3. Type “C”: 1+ inch
- 1st clip fleeces are classified as “Kid”. All subsequent clips should be entered in the appropriate “Adult” class.
- **Exhibitors must enter the fleece in a fresh clear plastic bag. Exhibitors must enter the fleece in a fresh clear plastic bag. Fleece Entry Tag must be filled out and placed inside the bag with the fleece. Fleece Show Entry Tag must be positioned so that it is visible and can be read without opening the bag.** Please have all information except on the Entry # filled out on each tag before you come to check in. You will receive your entry #(s) at check in.
- If a fleece is disqualified, the reason for disqualification shall be recorded on the scorecard and the judge’s worksheet.
- Fleeces will be judged on breed standards with an emphasis on the following:
 1. Condition and Cleanliness
 2. Fineness and Purity
 3. Uniformity
 4. Presentation and Skirting
 5. Character and Style
- Ribbons will be awarded to 4th Place.

Special Ribbon Awards

The following special ribbons will be awarded from all entrants based on judge’s choice:

- White Champion and Reserve White Champion
- Color Champion and Reserve Color Champion
- Best of Show

Fleece Drop Off and Pick Up

- **Exhibitors must enter the fleece in a fresh clear plastic bag. Appropriate Fleece Entry Tag must be filled out, placed inside the bag with the fleece and it must be visible.** You will find the Fleece Entry Tag form on the Fiber Fusion website in the "Forms" section.
- Fleeces may be dropped off at a designated collection site, mailed, or delivered directly to the show the evening prior to the event.
 - **REMOTE DROP OFF** - The following are designated as collection sites. Make arrangements directly with drop off site contact person.

**** Fleeces must be at the drop off site no later than Tuesday, October 11, 2016.**

- **MAIL IN** - If not attending Fiber Fusion Northwest, fleeces may be mailed to Megan Burlison – 2310 Hoyt Ave., Everett, WA 98201. Fleeces must arrive prior to October 11, 2016. Entries **MUST** be accompanied by a pre-paid, pre-addressed, return label from either FEDEX or UPS, and will be returned in the same box sent. We will be unable to return ribbons and fleece without this label, and those fleeces will be donated.
- **SHOW SITE CHECK-IN** – You may drop off your fleece at the show site on Friday, October 14, 2016, between the hours of 1:00 pm and 7:00 pm.
- Fleeces may be picked up at the show site after 3:00 pm on Sunday, October 16, 2016. At such time the PICK UP RECEIPT must be surrendered and matched to the fleece bag tag. You may also make arrangements to recover your fleece at one of the designated drop off sites. Mail-in fleece will be returned using the return label.

PLEASE NOTE: We will take care of your fleece within reason, but we are not responsible for loss or damage.
