

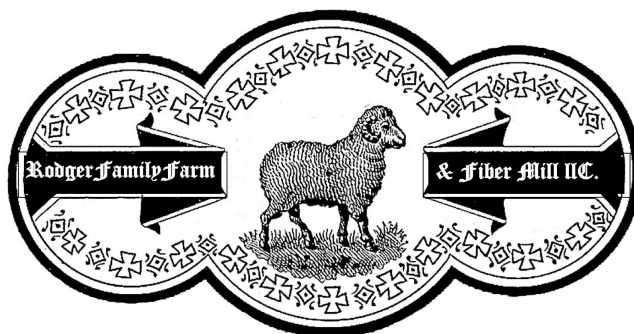


Fiber Fusion Northwest 2019 Demonstration Schedule of Events
