

FFNW ~ Fiber Arts Entry Options

Judging criteria for all entries:

- Judging will be anonymous, with points given for creativity, craftsmanship, hand-feel, visual appeal, appropriate use of fiber and technique, effectiveness, written description, intended use, and final finish.

Category: Youth (18 years and younger) or Adult (19 years and up)

Class A: Handspun Yarn

Skeins must be 25 to 200 yards & tied with four "figure-8" ties. Balls of yarn will not be accepted.

LOT NUMBER:

1. Singles.
2. 2-ply
3. Multi-ply
4. Novelty (art) yarn of choice
5. Fine-spun yarn
6. Other

Class B: Hand Knitted

LOT NUMBER:

1. Knitted articles with Handspun Yarn - article must be 70% or more handspun yarn
2. Knitted articles with Commercial Yarn - article must be 70% or more commercial yarn
3. Other

Class C: Hand Crocheted

LOT NUMBER:

1. Crocheted articles with Handspun Yarn - article must be 70% or more handspun yarn
2. Crocheted with Commercial Yarn - article must be 70% or more commercial yarn
3. Other

Class D: Handwoven

LOT NUMBER:

1. Woven Article
2. Basketry
3. Other

Class E: Wet-Felted

LOT NUMBER:

1. Wet Felted Articles

Class F: Needle-Felted

LOT NUMBER:

1. Needle Felted Articles

Class G: Mixed Media

All items not assignable to other classes.

Class H: Photography - Display Only

All photos must be related to our fiber community (fiber animals, fiber processing, fiber products, etc.)

Limited to the first 20 items. Matted and ready to hang (no frames please). Sizes 5x7 to 10x10.

Fiber Fusion Northwest – Fiber Arts Show Entry Information and Rules



- ❖ All entries must be completed after October 31st, 2019.
- ❖ Go to <https://www.fiberfusion.net/fiber-arts-show-2022.html> for Class, Lot, and other entry details.
- ❖ REGARDLESS OF HOW THE ACTUAL ITEM WILL BE DELIVERED, **you must PRE-REGISTER.**
Use one of 2 options (**on-line registration OR mail-in registration**) to PRE-REGISTER:
 - **On-line option:** Register and pay on our website at <https://www.fiberfusion.net/fiber-arts-show-2022.html>. On-line registration must be completed no later than June 2nd, 2022.
 - **Mail-in option:** Fill out the first page of this document and mail with payment to NSAA, P.O. Box 1131, Stanwood, WA 98292. Mail-in registration must be postmarked no later than May 19th, 2022. The deadline for mail-in entries is two weeks earlier than on-lineF registration to allow for postal delays.
- ❖ Once you have PRE-REGISTERED, there are 3 ways to get your actual fiber arts entries to us!
 - #1) **MAIL IN - Fiber Arts Entry**
 - Entries may be mailed to:
 - Fiber Fusion NW c/o Beth Cachat at 20701 150th Ave SE, Monroe, WA 98272.
 - Entries must be postmarked no later than May 19th 2022.
 - Entries **MUST be accompanied by a pre-paid, pre-addressed, return label** from USF Postal Service, and will be returned in the same box sent or in whatever container you provide. We will be unable to return ribbons and entries until shipping arrangementsF have been made.
 - #2) **SHOW SITE CHECK-IN** – Drop off your entry at the show site Thursday between 4-7pm, FridayF between 2-7 pm, or **by arrangement only: Saturday morning between 8-8:30am.**
 - #3) **REMOTE DROP OFF** – You may hand deliver your items to a designated collection site with aF member of Team Fiber Fusion. The following are designated as collection sites.
 - **Make arrangements directly with a drop off site contact person prior to delivering your item(s).**

Entries must be at the drop off site no later than Wednesday, June 1st, 2022.

- ❖ Entries MUST remain on display from 10:00 am Saturday, May 4th until 5:00 pm on Sunday, May 5th.
- ❖ Entries are to be picked up by Owner on Sunday, June 5th from 5:00 pm to 6:00 pm. Indicate on Fiber Arts Entry Form if you would like your entry(s) shipped to you (must send pre-paid, pre-addressed US Postal Service shipping label with registration).
- ❖ For each entry attach a 3" x 5" card with the following information (do not put any ID on this card).
 - Fiber Content
 - Statement of intended use
 - Preparation and techniques used in its creation
 - Original or commercial design
 - Supply a fiber sample, yarn sample or other component to demonstrate content
